

Sea Turtles and Sea Cow (Dugong)



- Mainstreaming CC vulnerability assessments e.g. Climate Risk Vulnerability Assessment (CRVA) for investment planning and implementation








CHALLENGES AND CONSTRAINTS

- Frequent turnover and transitions in government personnel, often in response to evolving events, can disrupt the continuity of data management and compromise the quality of information collected.
- Reduced financial allocations and constrained budgets pose significant challenges to the effective implementation
- Enforcing environmental laws and regulations within the CTI faces a series of challenges, including limited resources, complex jurisdictional issues, and the need for strengthened legal frameworks to combat illegal activities.




