



- Plans developed:

- Three (3) municipalities in Palawan developed fisheries management plan focused on Live Reef Fish (LRF)
- Local government has invested up to PhP1.8 million (\$37,000US) to finance personnel and logistical inputs to the management of its fisheries.

 - Municipality of Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro including generation of maps and video-documentation of process/ methodology applied.
- VIP-wide mangrove mapping completed and the results to feed to the municipal and provincial CCA Plan development
- Adaptive capacity of LGU and fishing community was measured as part of the Vulnerability Assessment on Sagay, Camiguin and Naic, Cavite.
- CCA Plans prepare for Sibutu and Sitangkai in Tawi Tawi province and in Dumaran in Palawan province.
