#### Session #8 Day 3, 24 November 2012 Other Matters

### Background

In the preparation of SOM8 and during the adoption of agenda, some countries and partners may propose separate issues to be presented in the Meeting. Those issues could simply an information sharing and presentation, introduction of new methodology/tool to work in the coastal/marine areas, or significant issue which will need attention from CT6 delegates.

As such, SOM8 agreed to scheduled 6 (six) issues to be presented. Two issues had been presented on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of SOM8, which was "Threatened Species Working Group" and "Coral Triangle Day". Those issues are covered independently and received its decision separately. Whereas on the third day of the SOM8, 4 (four) other issues were presented. Those issues are:

- 1. Integrating Coastal Resource Management and Planning in the Coral Triangle: *Practical Guidelines for Marine and Coastal Managers and Conservation Practitioners* – presented by US CTI
- 2. Support to the Implementation of the Tri-National SSME Comprehensive Action Planand Local Government Network Forum – presented by the Philippines
- 3. Prototype Mapping Tool presented by ADB
- 4. Development of Marine Conservation Center
