

No take zone

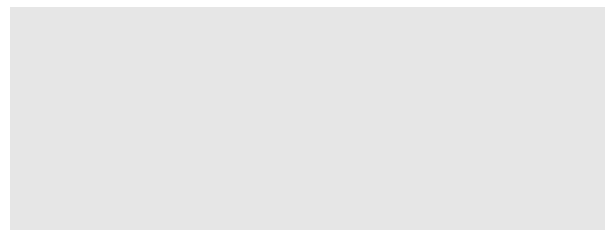
The Ministry of Agriculture and fisheries can establish no take areas through a Ministerial Diploma.

We are not doing no take zones everywhere!

Government may, after research and discussion with local authorities and fishermen help communities with the site selection for no take areas to ensure that areas are:

- Where fish hide;
- Where fish feed and get bigger;
- Where fish get together to breed;
- Where corals are growing and in good condition.

When do we establish a no take zone?

When community member have reasons to believe that:

- Fish are getting smaller compared with before;
- There is less fish variety in the catch;
- Other important resources for the community have been depleted or are in such low numbers that one rarely sees them.

Many fish inside Fishermen happy outside!



We can fish outside the protected areas. In this area there are many fish and fishermen can get income from fishing there sustainably. It takes 3-4 years for income to increase more and more.

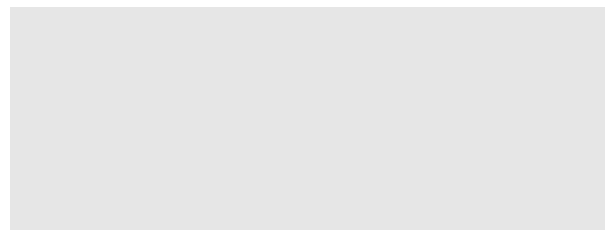
