Coral Triangle Initiative (CTI) was first initiated by the President of the Republic of Indonesia at the APEC High Level Leaders meeting Declaration on Climate Change, Energy Security and Clean Development in Sydney Australia in 2007. The Initiation was welcomed by leaders of other countries in the Coral Triangle region, namely Malaysia, Philippines,

Timor Leste, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, as well as the United States and Australia. Then following up this initiative in 2009, held a meeting in May CTI Summit in Manado of them agreed that the Regional Plan of Action (RPOA) and the National Plan of Action (NPOA). So since it's various programs and activities have been implemented, both at regional and national level in each country.

The Government of Indonesia has carried out various activities which closely tied to walk in the achievement of a number of objectives set out in the National Priority of Action (NPOA) as well as supporting activities.
