Background

The Coral Triangle Initiative for Coral Reefs, Fisheries, and Food Security (CTI-CFF) Regional Secretariat has been awarded a five-year grant by the United States Agency for International Development Regional Development Mission for Asia (USAID/RDMA). This grant aims to support sustainable management of marine biodiversity and fisheries resources in the Coral Triangle region, focusing on strengthening governance, building capacity, enhancing community engagement, and securing blue financing for conservation efforts.

Objectives

The two days Kick-off Meeting serves as a pivotal event to formally launch the USAID Sustainable Coral Triangle and initiate collaborative efforts among key stakeholders. The meeting aims to:

- Introduce USAID Sustainable Coral Triangle to CT6 member countries and stakeholders.
- Provide an overview of the project objectives, activities, and expected outcomes.
- Foster dialogue and engagement among government officials, CTI-CFF Regional Secretariat, implementing partners, USAID bilateral Missions and Offices, and other relevant stakeholders e.g., SEAFDEC, RPOA-IUU, etc.
- Outline the framework for monitoring and evaluation to track project progress effectively.
